Accel Entertainment, in consultation with Cheyenne Frontier Days "CFD", respectfully asks that you postpone consideration of today's agenda item on the application of Accel Entertainment for live horse racing at Frontier Park. Both Accel and CFD have been following the letter of the law in seeking this initial approval. Wyoming has a strong horse racing regulatory structure focused on the integrity of the sport, and *both parties support the laws and regulations of the State of Wyoming.*

CFD intends to take additional time to work with Mayor Collins and the City of Cheyenne to hear public concerns about horse racing at Frontier Park and solicit increased participation from all City residents. The City of Cheyenne has always been CFD's partner. While not required by law, CFD believes it is required by the spirit of our 128-year relationship with the City.

CFD has heard our neighbors. There are questions related to traffic control, the potential for noise, and other impacts. We will take the steps necessary to develop the needed information and present it to the City and our neighbors with regards to these concerns and present solutions.

CFD partnered with Accel because we believe the investment from them represents opportunities to improve our facilities and provide financial benefits. Accel is a professionally run company with a strong record of compliance. Accel, as a publicly traded company, must comply with federal regulatory requirements in addition to Wyoming laws and regulations. The Parties believe this will be a great long-term partnership that will provide significant tax revenue to city, county, and state general funds.

CFD will undertake and complete the process to begin horse racing at Frontier Park before we move forward with Accel.

Both Parties appreciate the time and attention community leaders have devoted to this project and remain committed to investing in the City of Cheyenne and the State of Wyoming.
