SHERIFF KOZAK CREATES INMATE COMMUNITY WORK CREW PROGRAM

On Monday May 20th, the Laramie County Sheriff's Office took an inmate work crew to the Burns Cemetery. The Inmates helped with mowing, weed eating, clearing tumble weeds off the fences, and picking up garbage. The inmates prepared the cemetery for Memorial Day, when visitors will come to visit deceased family members who served in the military.

Sheriff Kozak said, "When I brought this idea to the inmates, they were excited to give back to the community. The inmates had heart felt pride when community members thanked them for their hard work".

Individuals offered the opportunity to work outside of our facility are low risk inmates that have demonstrated good behavior while they've been incarcerated and are in jail for minor crimes. Each will be fitted with GPS trackers prior to leaving our facility and will be supervised by sheriff's deputies.

Sheriff Kozak created this new Inmate Work Crew Program to benefit our community. If you have a project for our crew that would benefit Laramie Counts, please contact Deputy Wiltanger at 307-633-4745. We ask that you provide lunch for the inmates while working on your project. You can also make donations to the program. Donations will be used to purchase safety equipment for the inmate workers.

The public will know when a work crew is in the area because large orange signs will be placed in the area which read, "SHERIFFS WORK CREW AHEAD".
